### To apply for Career Field Distinction, students must meet the following requirements:

1. Successful completion of 3 credits in a career field major elective.
2. Be an active participant in a CTSO (BPA, DECA, FCCLA, HOSA, or SkillsUSA) for a minimum of two years.
3. Complete a minimum of 60 hours of community service outside of the school day in your career field area.
4. Submit an application, including a transcript, which proves the student has met the requirements.
