



Fine Arts Distinction Requirements Flathead High School



Fine Arts Distinction acknowledges graduating seniors that complete a plan emphasizing a fine arts focus in one of the three Fine Art areas: Music, Theatre, or Visual Art. To be eligible for this distinction, the student must complete all requirements in one area. Students earning this distinction are eligible to wear a lavender color distinction cord at graduation.

Music department criteria for distinction:

1. Four consecutive credits in one of the three music performance courses: Choir, Band, or Orchestra
2. Cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher
3. Two Activity Letters in Music

Theatre department criteria for distinction:

1. Three credits of any of the existing theatre classes
2. Cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher
3. Two Activity Letters in Theatre

Visual Art department criteria for distinction:

1. Four credits of Visual Art
2. Submit an IB Studio Art SL or HL portfolio in spring of their graduating year
Or
(Non-IB Students) Submit a portfolio of their most outstanding original artworks showing significant artistic growth, mastery of technique, and a 1000 word artist's statement about their artwork.
3. Public exhibition of work in the Spring of the graduating year
4. Cumulative GPA of 3.2 or higher

Students must submit an application, including a transcript, which proves the student has met the requirements.
