Students will participate in extracurricular work and activities to achieve more in depth studies. These students will focus on the Kalispell World Language Content Standards (Culture, Connections, Communications, Comparisons, and Communities).

To apply for International Language Distinction, students must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Successful completion of 4 credits of a language
- 2. 3.2 minimum GPA in your chosen language
- 3. Portfolio or 2 years of another language
