Merit Distinction honors students who took rigorous courses yet did not meet the eligibility requirements for an IB Diploma. To be recognized as achieving Merit Distinction; a gold cord will be worn during graduation.

To apply for Merit Distinction, students must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Successful completion of six credits worth of IB classes, three of which you must have completed exams in. (ex: TOK 1&2 = 1 class & 1 credit)
- 2. Earn a minimum of 24 credits, meeting the requirements in the table below.
- 3. Submit an application, including a transcript, which proves the student has met the listed requirements.
